

ORDINANCE NO. 03-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIMONSON CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC. FOR THE OAK HILL CIRCLE SANITARY SEWER REMEDIATION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Oak Hill Circle Sanitary Sewer Remediation Project be implemented by the City of Ashland, Ohio, in order that the City may address a deficient condition within their sanitary sewer collection system; and

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance 24-13, which amended the City of Ashland's purchasing policy to reflect ORC Section 735.05, except that any purchases between \$25,000 and \$50,000 be subject to majority approval of Council,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Simonson Construction for the Oak Hill Circle Sanitary Sewer Remediation Project, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Engineering Division.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interests of the City of Ashland.

Section 3. That the money for said project has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 611-7201-55012 with a contract cost of thirty five thousand two hundred thirty dollars (\$35,230.00).

Section 4. That for the reason that the sanitary sewer remediation herein specified is needed in order for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio's sanitary sewer collection system, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
