

ORDINANCE NO. 42-14

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO BE USED IN LOW TO MODERATE INCOME AREAS AS A PART OF THE ANNUAL PAVING PROGRAM BID AS AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 35-14; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Ashland has additional funds available for paving to be designated within low to moderate income (LMI) census block groups as determined by the 2000 census; and

WHEREAS, improving this area would meet HUD's national objective of benefiting an area where the majority of the households are Low to Moderate Income (LMI) households; and

WHEREAS, detailed plans and specifications for the project have been prepared by the Engineering Division; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to include these additional funds and paving areas within the 2014 Annual Paving Project, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Engineer.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.

Section 3. That the estimated cost for the additional LMI area paving is sixty-four thousand one hundred ten dollars (\$64,110.00). The money has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 231-0000-11010. The Engineering Estimate for the 2014 Annual Paving Project will therefore be revised to three hundred ninety six thousand seven hundred fifty nine dollars (\$396,759.00).

Section 4. That in order to include these additional funds and paving areas within the 2014 Annual Paving Project, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
