

ORDINANCE NO. 48-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE WELLS ROAD WATERLINE EXTENSION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the Wells Road Waterline Extension Project be constructed by the City of Ashland, Ohio, in order that the City may create shovel ready sites and ensure redundancy in the public water supply within the Ashland Business Park; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract for the Wells Road Waterline Extension Project.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.

Section 3. That the money for said improvement project has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 265-3501-58002 (\$167,198.10) and Account No. (463-5601-55001 (\$32,801.90) with an Engineering Estimate of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00).

Section 4. That for the reason that the infrastructure project specified is needed to create shovel ready sites at the City of Ashland's Ashland Business Park, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
