

**ORDINANCE NO. 57-14**

**AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM ONE FUND TO ANOTHER; AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary, in order to meet the immediate financial needs of the City of Ashland, Ohio for the calendar year 2014, to transfer funds from one fund to another; now therefore,

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is a requirement of the Community Housing Grant regulations that Community Housing Program income be segregated from the Community Housing Grant Program; now therefore,

**Be It Ordained**, by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That the following transfer of funds for the calendar year 2014 for the City of Ashland, Ohio, be, and the same is hereby made as follows:

**Transferring Forty - Four Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars and Twenty - Seven cents from Fund 232 Ohio Regional Housing Fund (CHIP) to Fund 239 Housing Program Fund.**

**Section 2.** That in order to meet the immediate financial needs of the City of Ashland, Ohio this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
