

ORDINANCE NO. 82-14

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE 2015 TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO TO MEET THE ORDINARY OPERATING EXPENSES OF SAID CITY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.38; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio, desires to postpone the passage of the annual appropriations ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38; and

WHEREAS, for that reason it is immediately necessary to meet the ordinary operating expenses of said City, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland Ohio 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated by this Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio, pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38, a temporary appropriation measure, creating sufficient monies necessary to meet the ordinary operating expenses of said City for three months until such time as the annual appropriations ordinance is passed, but not later than April 1, 2015 said ordinary expenses defined as being set forth in the tax budget of said City for 2015 as prepared in July, 2014.

Section 2. For that reason it is immediately necessary to meet said ordinary operating expenses of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
