

RESOLUTION NO. 08-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE STATEWIDE GLASS RECYCLING INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Ashland previously passed Resolution No. 3-14, authorizing the Mayor, Director of Public Service, to file an application with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for the purpose of acquiring funds through the Community Recycling Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor was made aware by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, upon receipt of said Community Recycling Grant application, that the Statewide Glass Recycling Initiative Grant Program would be better suited to meet the City's application request; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3736 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to award Community Grants for the purpose of supporting community recycling and litter prevention activities; and

WHEREAS, glass is currently not being recycled as a part of the Sanitation Department's Recycling Program and as such, is deposited directly to a landfill; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor, Director of Public Service, will file an application in an attempt to receive said Grant funds, which requires no local match, to purchase material and equipment necessary for the creation and implementation of a community wide glass recycling program; and,

WHEREAS, the application must be submitted in a timely manner and as such this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio hereby endorses and supports the creation of a community wide glass recycling program and authorizes the Mayor to implement said program, if approved, as indicated in its application and being in conformance with the City's and Grant Agency's procurement policies.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland, Ohio, is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to administer the grant to complete said project as indicated in the application.

Section 3. That for the reason that the application herein specified is immediately needed in order to secure funding for the completion of the project for the convenience of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
