

RESOLUTION NO. 10-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE STORMWATER IMPROVEMENT FUND GRANT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to implement a storm water demonstration project within the primary downtown public parking lot; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor, Director of Public Service, will file an application in an attempt to receive said Grant funds for the purpose of implementing qualifying storm water best management practices within said parking lot; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor, Director of Public Service, intends to file an application to the Ohio Development Services Agency to receive Grant funds through the CDBG Downtown Revitalization Program, in an attempt to receive said Grant funds for the purpose of implementing qualifying storm water best management practices and further asphalt, sidewalk and curb rehabilitation within said parking lot; and,

WHEREAS, the application must be submitted by April 4, 2014 and as such this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio hereby endorses and supports the implementation of a demonstrative storm water management project for the community and authorizes the Mayor to implement said project, if approved, as indicated in its application, if all anticipated grant funding is obtained.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland, Ohio, is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to administer the grant to complete said project as indicated in the application.

Section 3. That for the reason that the application herein specified is immediately needed in order to secure funding for the completion of the project for the convenience of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.
