PROPOSED LEGISLATION
Ordinance – Amending Ordinance No. 8-15

LEGISLATION SUMMARY: This Ordinance amends Ordinance No. 8-15, Section 3.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY: Ordinance 8-15 authorized the Mayor to enter into a Contract with ODOT for additional waterline replacement work to be included within the US-42 Reconstruction Project.

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: The amount stipulated in Section 3 of Ordinance 8-15 was based on the Engineer's Estimate provided by ODOT. The lowest and most responsive bidder's bid came in significantly higher than the estimate. In order for the work to be awarded, the City will have to pay the increased contract price.

FISCAL IMPACT: The contract price for the additional waterline work is \$158,210.00 and is proposed to be funded by Account No. 601-6201-55011.

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION: After reviewing with the Mayor, it is recommended that this Ordinance be passed so that we can forward with implementing this work within the ODOT Project.

ORDINANCE NO. 21-15

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 8-15; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8-15 authorized and directed the Mayor, Director of Public Service, to enter into a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation for additional waterline replacement work to be included as part of the US-42 Reconstruction Project (ASD-42-7.75) in the City of Ashland; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation solicited competitive bids in accordance with law and the lowest and most responsive bidder's contract price for said waterline work exceeded the Engineering Estimate; and

WHEREAS, for the above reason, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5
members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 8-15 is hereby amended as followed:

Section 3. That the money for said work has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 601-6201-55011 with an ~~Engineer's Estimate of one hundred twenty four thousand one hundred and thirteen dollars (\$124,113.00)~~ a contract cost of one hundred fifty eight thousand two hundred ten dollars (\$158,210.00).

Section 2. That for the reason that the waterline replacement work herein specified is needed in order for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio's

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water distribution system, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace; property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
