

ORDINANCE NO. 39-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE SEWER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO, OBVIATING FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase equipment for the Sewer Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and,

Whereas, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland, Ohio and that the equipment as specified herein below is immediately necessary for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Sewer Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore:

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of equipment described immediately herein below for the Sewer Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio; obviating formal advertising and bidding for the reason that said equipment will be purchased through the existing State Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract or per House Bill 204 and conforming to the proposal on file in the office of the Director of City Utilities:


Total Cost: \$199,101.13


Section 2. That the cost for said equipment has been appropriated and will be paid from account 611-7201-55002.

Section 3. That for the reason that the equipment as specified herein above is immediately necessary for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Sewer Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
