

ORDINANCE 50-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ASHLAND MAKE AVAILABLE TWO DAYS OFF WITH PAY FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES TO SUPPORT THE UNITED WAY OF ASHLAND COUNTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the City of Ashland is a community leader and as such, should set the example and work to resolve the local issues of those citizens in need of basic necessities and services; and

Whereas, the City of Ashland has identified the commitment of the United Way of Ashland County to solving these local issues and recognizes their award winning performance in serving this community; and

Whereas, this Council desires to assist the United Way of Ashland County in solving these issues by raising the necessary funding; and

Whereas, for the reasons set forth, the Mayor is authorized and directed to make available a total of two days off with pay for the purposes of conducting a raffle for the sole purpose of raising funds for the United Way of Ashland County, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare; now therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That this Council supports and authorizes the fund raising activities of the City of Ashland's United Way Team and that the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for employee voluntary participation in said activities.

Section 2. That this Council authorizes the Mayor to conduct such activities in accordance with the rules set forth by the City of Ashland United Way Team and award one day off with pay to the winner of the raffle for Union employees and one day off with pay to the winner of the raffle for Ordinance employees. The two days off with pay shall be used before December 31, 2015, scheduled in accordance with Division policies and cannot be cashed in or traded.

Section 3. That for the reason that said fund raising activities are part of the 2016 United Way campaign starting August 13, 2015, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
