

ORDINANCE NO. 57-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; OBVIATING FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase equipment for the Division of Police of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Police of said City of Ashland, Ohio, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio 5 members there to concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following used equipment for the Division of Police of the City of Ashland, Ohio, with Asia Motors of Stone Park Illinois.

One (1) 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe Police SUV and One (1) 2009 Chevrolet Tahoe Police SUV, at a price not to exceed \$64,000 for both vehicles.


and conforming to specifications on file at the Ashland Division of Police.


Section 2. That the money for said equipment be paid out of the 405 Capital Improvement fund in a method as determined by the Finance Director.



That for reason that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Police of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately needed for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio
