

ORDINANCE NO. 66-15

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING COUNCIL'S INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE NAME OF A CERTAIN STREET WITHIN RECENTLY ANNEXED TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain territory, including a portion of County Road 1575, has recently been annexed into the City of Ashland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is the Ashland City Council's intention to designate a name for that portion of County Road 1575, within the City of Ashland, Ohio; and


WHEREAS, for the above reasons, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare; now therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the portion of County Road 1575 which is now within the City of Ashland, Ohio and such portion as may hereafter be annexed by the City, be known and is hereby designated as Montgomery Road, said name being in memory of William Montgomery, the founder of Ashland.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
