

ORDINANCE 84-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR RENEWAL OF THE HEALTH INSURANCE AND LIFE, DENTAL AND VOLUNTARY LIFE INSURANCE FOR THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the current provisions for health and life insurance and voluntary dental, life and vision insurance for employees, and family members thereof, of the City of Ashland expire December 31, 2015, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, has solicited proposals for renewal of such health and life insurance and voluntary dental, life and vision insurance, consistent with the existing provisions thereof; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to renew provisions for such health and life insurance and voluntary dental, life and vision insurance; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain continuity in the provision of such health and life insurance and voluntary dental, life and vision insurance, said current policies expiring December 31, 2015, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare; now therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. The Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for health and life insurance and voluntary dental, life and vision insurance effective January 01, 2016, for the City of Ashland employees and family members thereof, in conformity with the specifications attached hereto and made part hereof, and that renewals thereof, on a continuing basis are, hereby authorized to be entered.


Section 2. That for the reason that the current provisions for health and life insurance and voluntary dental and life insurance expire on December 31, 2015, this Ordinance hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.


