

ORDINANCE NO. 85-15

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY SERVICES DIVISION OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO, OBTAINING FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase equipment for the City Services Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City Service Division of said City of Ashland, Ohio, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following equipment for the City Service Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio, obviating formal advertising and bidding, due to the purchase through the existing State Cooperative purchasing agreement contract, or per House Bill 204.

Description of equipment

One (1) New Caterpillar Model 914K Compact Wheel Loader
STS number 800055, Index number STS515

Total cost \$116,748 less sale of 1985 Caterpillar 920 (ST047), serial no. 94Z03618ST047 amended to serial no. 62K13365ST047 via GovDeals or assured trade in of \$8,000 whichever is of greater value to the City

And conforming with the more detailed specifications on file in the City Service Division.


Section 2. That the money for said equipment be paid from Account Nos. 601-6202-55002 - \$36,250.00, 611-7201-55002 - \$36,250.00, 619-8001-55004 - \$36,250.00.

Section 3. That for the reasons that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City Service Division of the City of Ashland, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately needed for the preservation of the public peace, property, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
