

ORDINANCE NO. 38-16

AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING THE AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY DISPATCH SERVICES.

Whereas, although not specifically renewed, the City of Ashland may remain subject to certain terms or agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Ashland County and the Ashland County Sheriff whether by course of dealing or otherwise;

Whereas, this Council desires to terminate any such agreement; and

Whereas, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Ashland does terminate effective June 30, 2016 any agreement with Board of Commissioners of Ashland County and the Ashland County Sheriff for the provision of emergency dispatch services.

Section 2. That the Clerk is instructed to deliver a true copy of this Ordinance to the Board of Commissioners of Ashland County at least sixty days prior to June 30, 2016.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
