

ORDINANCE NO. 39-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ASSIGN THE TITLE OF A 2004 FORD CUTAWAY VAN TO BURGESS HEARSE AND AMBULANCE SALES INC.; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 27-15 authorized the purchase of a 2014/2015 E-450 Ford chassis to be mounted to an existing, refurbished EMS module for the Fire Division. However Ordinance 27-15 did not authorize the trading-in or assigning of the 2004 Ford cutaway van title; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the intended purchase price of the 2014/2015 e-450 Ford chassis was the trading-in of the 2004 Ford cutaway van, the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to assign the title of the 2004 Ford cutaway van to Burgess Hearse and Ambulance Sales Inc., now therefore,

Be It Ordained, by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to assign the title of the 2004 Ford cutaway van to Burgess Hearse and Ambulance Sales Inc.

Section 2. That in order to meet the immediate financial needs of the City of Ashland, Ohio this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
