

ORDINANCE NO. 41-16

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIMONSON CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC, FOR THE FRANKLIN AVENUE STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary that the Franklin Avenue Storm Sewer Improvement Project be implemented by the City of Ashland, Ohio, in order that the City may improve its storm water collection system; and

**WHEREAS**, for the above reason, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the Franklin Avenue Storm Sewer Improvement Project, in accordance with the construction documents and specifications on file in the office of the Engineering Division.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interests of the City of Ashland.

**Section 3.** That the money for said project has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 602-7209-55005 with a contract cost of twenty-four thousand five hundred forty-seven dollars (\$24,547.00).

**Section 4.** That for the reason that the Franklin Avenue Storm Sewer Improvement Project herein specified is needed in order for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio's storm water collection system, this Ordinance is declared to be an

emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

**Section 5.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.

**LEGISLATION SUMMARY:** This Ordinance authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Simonson Construction for the construction of the Franklin Avenue Storm Sewer Improvement Project.

**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:** None

**LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:** This project involves the replacement and addition of storm sewer conveyance systems along Franklin Drive. The City will provide material purchased under the material bid contracts.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This Project will be funded via the Storm Water Utility Account No. 602-7209-55005. The contract amount is for \$24,547.00.

**DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION:** After reviewing with the Mayor, it is recommended that this Ordinance be passed so that we can forward with implementing this Project.
