

ORDINANCE NO. 47 -16

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR OPERATIONAL AND IMPLEMENTATION COSTS OF REGIONAL DISPATCH SERVICES THAT WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE WOOSTER - ASHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Wooster - Ashland Regional Council of Governments is in the process of developing and implementing a regional dispatch service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ashland believes that it is the City's best interest in protecting and providing services to its citizens to utilize dispatch services; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the development and implementation of such services will exceed the \$25,000.00 threshold requiring legislative authorization; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize said expenditures; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the necessary authorization for payments for said services, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That payments for operational invoices submitted by the Wooster - Ashland Regional Council of Governments for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, be and the same are hereby, approved. The money for said payments have been appropriated and will be paid from Account No. 101-2211-58001.

Section 2. That payments for implementation invoices submitted by the Wooster - Ashland Regional Council of Governments for a total amount not to exceed \$210,858.00, be and the same are hereby, approved. The money for said payments have been appropriated and will be paid from Account No. 405-4697-58001.

Section 3. That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized to approve said invoices and payments as they are submitted from the Wooster - Ashland Regional Council of Governments on behalf of the City of Ashland. Likewise, the Director of Finance is authorized to pay said invoices.

Section 4. For the reason that it is necessary to provide authorization for said payments, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
