

ORDINANCE NO. 52-16

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIAL FOR THE STREET DIVISION OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; OBVIATING FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING; RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE FILING OF THE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for municipal corporations created under Chapter 1545 of the Revised Code, to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase material for the Street Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio and for the further reason that the deadline for submitting completed participation agreements for the 2016 Sodium Chloride (Rock Salt) Cooperative Purchasing Program was May 27, 2016; and

WHEREAS, due to the passage of said deadline, said participation agreement submission must be ratified and approved; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to enter into a contract to purchase the following material for the Street Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio, obviating formal advertising and bidding, in conjunction with the Cooperative Purchasing Program which the Division has entered into pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B).

**SODIUM CHLORIDE/Rock Salt**

Section 2. That the money for said material shall be paid from Account No. 202-1001-53010.

Section 3. That for the reason that the deadline for submitting completed participation agreements for the 2016 Sodium Chloride (Rock Salt) Cooperative Purchasing Program was May 27, 2016, the timely submission of said Agreement is hereby ratified and approved and, further, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
