

ORDINANCE NO. 6476

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 107 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO.**

**WHEREAS**, The State of Ohio has enacted House Bill 180 which prohibits local governments from requiring a contractor to employ a certain percentage of individuals from the geographic area of the local government for the construction or professional design of a public improvement and further prohibits a public authority from providing a bid award bonus or preference to a contractor as an incentive to employ as laborers a certain number or percentage of individuals who reside within the defined geographic area or service area of the local government; and

**WHEREAS**, the enactment of House Bill 180 effectively nullifies Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Ashland; now therefore

4 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Ashland, Ohio be, and the same is hereby, repealed.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
