

ORDINANCE NO. 71-16

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIMONSON CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC. FOR THE EASTLAKE DRIVE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary that the Eastlake Drive Culvert Replacement Project be implemented by the City of Ashland, Ohio, in order that the City may improve their storm water conveyance system; and

**WHEREAS**, for the above reason, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the Eastlake Drive Culvert Replacement Project, in accordance with the specifications now on file in the office of the Engineering Division.

**Section 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interests of the City of Ashland.

**Section 3.** That the money for said improvement project has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 602-7209-5008 with a contract cost of forty four thousand eight hundred fifty four dollars (\$44,854.00). The precast concrete culvert will be purchased separately, directly from the Manufacturer.

**Section 4.** That for the reason that the new culvert herein specified is needed in order for the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio's storm water conveyance system, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

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**Section 5.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.

**Ordinance – Eastlake Drive Culvert Replacement Project**

**LEGISLATION SUMMARY:** This Ordinance authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Simonson Construction for the construction of the Eastlake Drive Culvert Replacement Project.

**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:** None

**LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:** The existing Eastlake Drive culvert is severely dilapidated and needs to be replaced. The existing culvert has multiple pipes, which are to be replaced with a single precast concrete box culvert.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This Project will be funded via the Storm Water Utility Culvert Replacement Account No. 602-7209-5008. The contract amount is for \$44,854.00. The City will be purchasing the precast concrete culvert separately, directly from the Manufacturer. The lowest quote for the culvert was \$13,920.

**DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION:** After reviewing with the Mayor, it is recommended that this Ordinance be passed so that we can forward with this Project.
