

ORDINANCE NO. 74-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 95-15, WHICH AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the advertised bid included a credit towards the Water Department's existing valve turner maintenance trailer/hydro-excavator; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and most responsive bidder provided a trade-in credit of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for the equipment, amounting to a total contract cost of fifty five thousand five hundred dollars (\$55,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the remaining bidders provided trade-in credits of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and zero dollars (\$0.00); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 95-15 did not specify that the existing equipment was to be included within the bid for a trade-in credit; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 95-15, is hereby, amended, to include the trade-in of the existing equipment as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract to purchase the following equipment for the Water Department of said City of Ashland, Ohio; in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Engineering Division:

One (1) Valve Turner Maintenance Trailer/Hydro-Excavator

Price: Not to exceed \$65,000.00

Bids shall include a trade-in credit for the following equipment:
One (1) E.H Wachs VMT-1 Valve Turner Maintenance Trailer/Hydro-Excavator
