

RESOLUTION NO. 15-15

A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING COUNCIL'S INTENTION REGARDING THE RESERVATION OF RIGHT PERTAINING TO THE VACATION OF A CERTAIN ALLEY AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 24-15; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, this Council retained a certain right to use a vacated alley in Ordinance No. 24-15; and

Whereas, this Council desires to clarify the scope of such reservation of right; and

Whereas, due to time constraints for property closing and new construction in the area of the vacated alley, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare; now therefore,


Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That this Council states that the intention of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 24-15 was and is, with respect to the reservation of right "to use all or any part of said alley," that such right pertains only to any utilities, public or private, existing at the time of vacation of said alley, and, in this particular instance, the only existing utility is that of a public storm sewer.

Section 2. That due to time constraints for property closing and new construction in the area of the vacated alley, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
