

**RESOLUTION \_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THAT THE CITY OF ASHLAND CELEBRATED ITS 200<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY IN 2015 AND COMMEMORATED THIS BY BURING A TIME CAPSULE AT BROOKSIDE PARK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**Whereas**, the City of Ashland celebrated its 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary culminating with the burial of a time capsule and placement of a stone marker; and

**Whereas**, this Council desires to memorialize the location of such time capsule located at 40.871397, -82.330469 in decimal degrees and 40d52'17.03" N, 82d19'49.69" W in degrees, minutes and seconds; and

**Whereas**, this Council desires to publicly thank the sponsors and individuals contributing to the bicentennial celebration; and

**Whereas**, for the reason that said time capsule was buried on October 21, 2015, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare; now therefore,

**Be It Resolved** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, \_\_\_ members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That this Council supported, participated and endorsed the City's 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary through various events and funding and that the Mayor authorized City employees to take the necessary steps to select and gather items for the time capsule soliciting community input.

**Section 2.** That the time capsule was dedicated on July 28, 2015 in a ceremony at the Bandshell and was buried on October 21, 2015 to allow for the inclusion of bicentennial items.

**Section 3.** That for the reason that said time capsule was buried at 40.871397, -82.330469 in decimal degrees and 40d52'17.03" N, 82d19'49.69" W in degrees, minutes and seconds on City owned property in a hole 3' x 3' x 4', this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
