

RESOLUTION NO. 29-15


Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That this Council supports, authorizes and ratifies the filing of an application with the **FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION – ASSISTANCE to FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG)** for a MARCS Radio Equipment, and that the Mayor be, and he is authorized, to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 2. That for the reason that said application is required to be filed by **January 15, 2016**, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.


