

ORDINANCE NO. 30-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 113.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, Codified Ordinance Section 113.01 was originally adopted in 1974; and

Whereas, significant technological changes have occurred, since 1974, relating to methods of communication and the efficiencies thereof; and

Whereas, in order to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of the Office of Clerk of Council and for the convenience of the Members of Council, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland Ohio 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Ashland, Ohio be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

113.01 READING OF LEGISLATION.

Every ordinance and resolution shall be fully and distinctly read at three regular and/or special meetings of Council on three different days. An ordinance or resolution shall be deemed to have been fully and distinctly read at any regular or special meeting of Council if a written or printed copy of the ordinance or resolution has been served upon each Councilman MEMBER by personal service thereof or by delivery thereof to his THE COUNCIL MEMBER'S City residence OR, UPON AUTHORIZATION BY ANY MEMBERS OF COUNCIL, TO SUCH AUTHORIZING MEMBERS BY E-MAIL TO THE E-MAIL ADDRESS SPECIFIED BY SUCH MEMBERS, at least ninety-six hours prior to the start of such regular or special meeting of Council; provided, however, that any such ordinance or resolution shall be read in full at any regular or special meeting of Council at the request of any member of Council. Council may suspend the above rule requiring three readings of an ordinance or resolution on three different days by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of Council.

Section 2. That in order to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of the Office of Clerk of Council and for the convenience of the Members of Council, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
